## Health Room Reminder

As you know, this year the flu season is a particularly bad one. This new virus seems to start as a low grade temp. and elevates to over 100 after only a short while. If your child complains before school that they are not feeling well, and his/her temp. is low, there is a good chance it will go higher in about an hour. You may want to keep them home to avoid having only to return to school to pick them up. If you receive a phone call from the health room to pick up your child, they **must be picked up within one hour**.
